- A generic starter packet for NCs interested in funding a member group will be designed in an international team.
- CIGRE YM groups will jointly formulate a proposal about funding the international YM Steering Committee.

This web-meeting is based on the agreements shown above and is the first step to succeed the mentioned targets.

3.1 CIGRE YMG Recommendations for founding YMGs – Best Practice Guide

The existing CIGRE Young Member Groups are still under development and face various challenges. These challenges vary from group to group due to different national, geographical and cultural backgrounds. Therefore, it is very hard to elaborate a "Step-by-Step Guide" for new groups because the described roles may not fit for the dedicated groups. Instead, it is agreed that most value will be created, if every Young Member Group prepares a detailed report about the foundation phase and ways of overcoming challenges. It is concluded, that this reports will be merged into one "Best-Practice and Experience Guide" which will give assistance to new groups. This guide will be presented and distributed at CIGRE Session 2014.

3.2 CIGRE Young Member Newsletter

It is agreed to initiate a "CIGRE Young Member Global" Newsletter for all CIGRE Young Members all around the world. NGN UK will provide the first issue. CIGRE NGN will contact each member group in order to submit and propose news for this newsletter. It is recommended to provide national information as well. NGN assumes to be able to publish the first issue in March. Andreas will provide a short summary of this meeting for the newsletter.





Figure 2. Professional Advisor Program model


